**11. NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL HIGHWAYS MATTERS**

- i) Annexe A : Scawby Brook – ditch running along Silversides Lane – has been inspected – weeds sprayed to prevent growth, debris removed and a JCB sent to clear a section of the dyke.
- ii) New highways matters to report:  
The footpath running over the motorway towards Broughton crossroads is overgrown with weeds and needs attention.  
The footpath on the left hand side as you enter Greetwell on Messingham Lane needs sealing and patching – a member of the public has tripped on this footpath recently.

**12. PLAYING FIELD AND VILLAGE MATTERS.**

- i) New village matters:  
Daffodil bulbs for Guides to plant – **IT WAS RESOLVED** to set a budget of £25 to purchase the daffodil bulbs. The Chairman to investigate and purchase.  
Hedge at The Pinfold – **IT WAS RESOLVED** that Jim Brown would be asked to cut this hedge and this would be undertaken when convenient.  
A discussion took place regarding the row of cottages adjacent to the village hall, owned by Nelthorpe Estate. Their appearance is untidy and clerk is to ask what the intention of The Estate is for these cottages.  
The property in St Hybalds with an untidy garden has still not improved. It was felt that little could be done about this matter.  
The dyke behind the Rookery which received attention from N.L.C after the 2007 floods requires further attention. Clerk to ask N.L.C to inspect the dyke and maintain it in a condition for the purpose it is required to do.  
A shrub and a tree is overhanging the pavement on Chapel Lane and a hedge is overhanging the pavement on Church Street.  
The Chairman has met the Scunthorpe Telegraph newspaper reporter for the Ridge Ward who will welcome any community news from our area.
