5. PLANNING

We have had quite a few plans submitted this year, most of them were residential alterations. The other main ones were:-

Primitive Methodist Chapel – No progress on this development yet.

West Street – 2 self-contained flats, well under construction.

Some plans were rejected due to being outside the building line. However since these were submitted NLC has changed the building line (after consultation). Therefore sum of these may be re-submitted.

6. FINANCE.

Finance has gone well this year, we have a surplus of about £25000.

Flowerbed sponsorship has gone well again.

Continuous Income from Football Teams.

Donations were given to:- Scawby Sunbeams, St Hybalds PCC, 1st Hibaldstow and Scawby Scouts, 1st Scawby Brownies, Horticultural Society,.

The rest of the PC expenses and income are as per financial statement.

7. POLICE MATTERS

Due to vehicle speeds around the village we have had the following carried out:-

Vehicle speed checks have taken place on various places around the Parish.

We have also had erected speed awareness signs. These are the digital type that indicate actual speed.

A slight increase 3% in burglaries around the Parish.

8. NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL HIGHWAYS MATTERS

Potholes have again been appearing around the village, most are repaired after NLC have been informed. Certain roads and paths have been re-surfaced.

Discussions have taken place with NLC about having a weight restriction placed on the village to reduce HGV traffic.

Fly tipping is becoming a regular occurrence around the Parish.

Still no outcome regarding the grass verges in Scawby Brook.

The sale of the Grove has not yet been finalised.

9. PLAYING FIELD AND VILLAGE MATTERS.

A project to re-furbish the Pavilion was initiated and funds have been set aside, also a grant of £10000 has been received from NLC to help with this.

Xmas light switch on was a success again, thanks to the Village Hall and Scawby Events Team for assisting, also Jim Brown and the Nelthorpe Estate for providing tree.

Litter pick around Scawby was a success.

Business in the community gave a make over to the village green, painting and gardening.

Front Garden competition was held again with the winners being announced at the Horticultural Show.

New seat installed at the Pinfold.

Tree planting scheme is under review for the Parish.

We have a small amount of Graffiti around the village.

Scawby was once again the winner of the Village in Bloom contest and also The Best Kept Playing field.

Seat at Scawby Brook needs replacing.

10. OTHER ITEMS

Thanks to NLC for grants towards notice boards.

Civic service was held again at the Parish Church. A buffet reception was held after in the Village Hall.

Scawby Events Team have once again organised many events during the year, thanks to them for this.
